Dear Parents and Students,

Covid-19 Update

Three more Covid-19 (novel coronavirus) cases have been identified in Malaysia, bringing the total number to 22. A few parents have written in to me personally to ask how we are monitoring the situation. I decided to use this newsletter to address all of you. Here is what we have done as a school;

- We have asked all our students if they have been back to China recently. None have, even the two Chinese Nationals who are our students.
- We have enquired with our students if any of their parents have been to China for work
 or have been exposed to anyone from the region. I have been informed in the negative
 to this as well.

- We have increased the frequency of cleaning of our common areas and classrooms.
- Hand sanitisers are in place outside every washroom.
- Students have been requested to stay away from school if they have flu like symptoms.
- We send back students should the child feel sick or develop a fever while in school.

Its works as usual in school except for few minor setbacks. We are unable to plan trips frequented by tourists. Trips for our Earth Week are as scheduled. We are hoping once the weather changes in Wuhan and other parts of China, the flu outbreak will subside.

Phone APP Use and its monitoring

- 3. TikTok: All the kids love it, and even some adults use it.
- 4. <u>Ask fm:</u> Anytime you have an app geared towards adolescents hiding their identity, parents should be worried.
- 5. <u>Kik:</u> **Kik** is a cross-platform application **used for** communicating with friends in group chats or direct messages. Initially, **Kik** looks just like any other instant messaging service. 6. Tinder: Dating app
