- Food trucks are coming in with loads of fun food. All food purchases will be in cash.
- We also inviting some children from a Myanmar Refugee Camp (Chin Community from Taman Maluri). They will put up a performance for us and will also be selling some lovely handbags that the ladies in their community make. Any help given to them will go a long way towards empowering them.

There are loads of activities that have been planned for that day besides the usual games stall that the students are putting up.

- Food/Coffee as well as gelato trucks along the road next to the field.
- Special home-made vegetarian food available too.
- Canned drinks sold by the TCC as a part of fund raising activity
